



## Connecticut ESSER Funding by Coronavirus Relief Legislation



### CARES Act (ESSER I)

Signed into law in **March 2020**.

### CRRSA Act (ESSER II)

Signed into law in **December 2020**.

### ARP Act (ESSER III)


Signed into law in **March 2021**.

**ESSER:** The Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund was created by Congress to help states and school districts across the country combat the impacts of COVID-19 on students and K-12 education.

**How ESSER Funds are Distributed:** Based on Title I, Part A, which provides federal funding to school districts with high numbers of students from low-income families.

**Funds May be Used For** (among other things): Preventing & Responding to COVID-19; Implementing Activities to Address Student Needs; Staff Training; and Purchasing Technology.

**8** Sept. 30, 2022  
Last day for states and school districts to allocate CARES funds

**9** Sept. 30, 2023  
Last day for states and school districts to allocate CRRSA funds

Last day for states and school districts to allocate ARP funds
